

Faith Baptist Christian School Important Registration Information

Priority Registration: Faith Baptist Christian School families and Faith Baptist Church members are given the opportunity to take advantage of a two week priority registration period prior to registration being made open to the public on Jan 28th. Classes will be filled on a first come first served basis. At that time, current FBCS students can not be guaranteed placement for the upcoming school year. *Students are not permitted to register if there is an outstanding balance on their account.*

Priority registration begins January 14th at 9:00 AM..

The school office must receive the following at the time of registration: completed registration form, parent school agreement (**signed by both parents for each application**), registration fees (with check payable to FBCS) and a completed FACTS agreement (provided for 1st time FACTS users).

FBCS and FBC Families Registering More than One Child: Families registering more than one child may opt to pay their registration fees all at once or in the following manner:

All registration fees must be paid when they are due to ensure placement.

Any child who has unpaid registration at the time it is due will be removed from guaranteed placement and put on the waiting list.

Public Registration: Registration will open to the public January 30th at 9:00 AM. in the school office. Classes will be filled on a first come first served basis. In order to register your child the school office must receive the following at the time of registration: completed registration form, parent school agreement (**both signed for each child**), registration fees (make checks payable to FBCS), a completed FACTS agreement and a copy of your child's birth certificate.

Uniform Policy: Kindergarten through middle school students will be required to wear FBCS approved uniforms. Preschoolers are welcome, but not required to wear the school uniform, but must follow the Tag Day dress code guidelines. (See Parent Handbook)

Potty Training: Absolutely all students entering FBCS, including preschoolers, must be potty trained at the time school starts.

Entrance Exam: All new students 1st-8th grade are required to take an entrance exam. The cost is \$25 per exam and must be paid at the time of the exam. Exams will be scheduled at a later date.

Age Requirement: Children entering school must be 3 years old and 4 years old by September 1st for Preschool and 5 years old by September 1st for Kindergarten.
